This is a reminder that your BWC policy is due by March 7, 2016. If you have not already submitted a policy, please do so before this date.

You may send the policy to jfennell@sccja.sc.gov. Once received, your policy will be reviewed to make sure it conforms to the Guidelines set forth by LETC.¹ If your policy is approved, you will receive a letter stating so. You must attach a copy of this approval letter² to your request for funding from the Department of Public Safety's Public Safety Coordinating Council. Please note, that the Academy must approve your policy before you may apply for these funds. Once again, your policy must be submitted to the Academy by March 7, 2016, pursuant to S.C. Code 23-1-240.
