SOUTH CAROLINA LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING COUNCIL

ORDER 2020-LETC-001

Pursuant to South Carolina Code of Laws Section 23-23-40, South Carolina Code of Laws Section 23-23-80, South Carolina Code of Laws Section 23-23-100, South Carolina Code of Regulations 37-002, and South Carolina Code of Regulations 37-005:

IT IS ORDERED that Class 3 Officers may only perform the following duties:

1. Court Room Security;
2. Special Assignments, e.g. sporting events, crowd control (this does not include civil unrest), traffic at fairs, football games, and transportation of detainees and/or prisoners;
3. Litter Control;
4. Litter and Animal Control;
5. Airport Security;
6. Administrative duties, such as duty officer and/or desk officer;
7. Civil Process;
8. Class 3 Officers, who also possess a Class 2 Certification, may perform the duties of a local detention officer;
9. May supervise Class 1, Class 2, and/or Class 3 Officers in the performance of administrative duties; and
10. SCDNR Class 3 officers may provide safety and security patrols upon all department managed properties.

Utilizing a Class 3 Officer for any other duty may subject the agency to a civil penalty of up to \$1,500.00. This Order will become effective January 1, 2021.
